- We have moved onto our new topic! This week we have been learning about... Dinosaurs! Our story for the week has been "Harry and a bucketful of Dinosaurs" by Ian Whybrow. We also have a dinosaur cave in our new role play area where the children can create different stories around dinosaurs.

- Our Nursery Rhyme for the week is '5 little monkeys'

Five little Monkeys jumping on the bed
One fell off and bumped their head
Mummy called the doctor and the doctor said

No more monkeys jumping on the bed!

(then repeat with 4 little monkeys, 3, 2, 1)

- Our Number for the Week is 10. Ask your child if they can count 10 claps, 10 stomps, 10 objects and write the number 10. Also, revise numbers 1-9 by using lots of counting games.
- Our Letter of the week is 'g'. Ask your child if they can think of things that begin with the sound 'g' (not the letter name 'gee'... It has to be e.g. 'g-g-goggles' 'g-g-glasses' etc.) Can they write the letter 'g'? Play games such as "I spy" to revise previously learnt letters which are s, a, t, p, i, n, m & d.
