

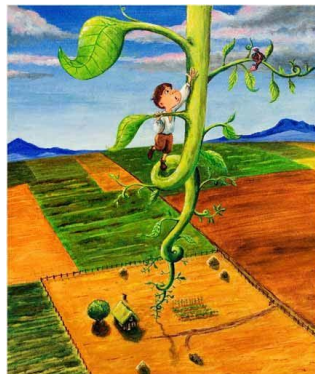
Nursery News Letter

Things such as running away from the Giant outside, playing a P.E game with different types of beans e.g. runner beans, jumping beans, etc. We have been planting our very own beanstalks and acting out the story.

- We have been playing lots of different counting games with beans to enhance our maths skills. Games such as; sorting counting them into the correct numbered pot, ordering beanstalks in size and ordering them to the correct numeral.
- Our Letter we have been learning this week is 'u'. Ask your child if they can think of things that begin with the sound 'u' (not the letter name 'you'... It has to be e.g. 'u-u-p', 'u-u-umbrella' etc.) Can they write the letter 'u'? Play games such as "I spy" to revise previously learnt letters which are s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c, k & u.
