- Our Nursery Rhyme for the week is '5 little monkeys'

(then repeat with 4 little monkeys, 3, 2, 1)

- Our Number for the Week is 10. Ask your child if they can count 10 claps, 10 stomps, 10 objects and write the number 10. Also, revise numbers 1-9 by using lots of counting games.
- Our Letter of the week is 'g'. Ask your child if they can think of things that begin with the sound 'g' (not the letter name 'gee'... It has to be e.g. 'g-g-goggles' 'g-g-glasses' etc.) Can they write the letter 'g'? Play games such as "I spy" to revise previously learnt letters which are s, a, t, p, i, n, m & d.
