Communication and Language

Consists of 3 strands:

- 1. Listening and attention the children will listen to stories and rhymes and be promoted to join in. Playing listening games with farm noises or musical instruments will help focus their attention
- Understanding children will be asked to respond to simple instructions such as tidy up time and answer simple questions
- 3. Speaking the children will be encouraged to join in with nursery stories on a daily bases and have the opportunity to talk and share their thought and ideas during Key Person Time

Numeracy

The children will have the opportunity to explore shapes and numbers on a daily basis. Counting will be incorporated into as many lessons as possible.

PSE

Managing Feelings and Behaviour
Children in our Nursery will be
expected to co-operate within the
rules and boundaries within the daily
routine.

Making Relationships

All children will be encouraged to form positive relationships with peers and adults. They will play activities that develops turn taking and sharing skills.

Self-confidence and Awareness

The children will be encouraged to express their own interests and preferences. They will also become responsible for carrying out small tasks such as collecting fruit and feeding the snail.

EAD

We will help develop the children's imagination by reading a range of stories and encouraging roleplay and small world play. They can play musical instruments and experiment with colour and textures

Physical Development

Moving and Handling

Children will be taught how to move in a range of ways to improve their co-ordination and balance and how to use small and large equipment safely e.g. scissors and climbing frame.

Health and Self Care

The children will be encouraged to become independent when using the toilet and having snack.

Understanding the World

The children will develop their technology skills as they will have access to computer, smart board and ipad on a daily basis. They will be encouraged to talk about their home and people who are special to them. They will be taught to show care and concern for living things and the environment.
