Fine motor: In the story, Robin has lots of vests. Create a little washing line with string and pegs between chair legs to hang out paper cut out/real clothes!

Gross motor: Skittles - simply use rolled-up socks as a ball, and empty bottles or toilet roll tubes as the skittles. Play inside or out, and ask your little one to describe what they are doing as the action happens.
