## World Book Day!

This year for World Book Day, the children and adults of Monksdown dressed up as a word. They were very creative and really thought hard about the word that they would come dressed up as!
In class, the children took part in a series of exciting activities.
Nursery enjoyed reading and completing activities based on 'The Gruffalo' by Julia Donaldson.
Reception read the Tiger came for tea and took part in a character hunt. After that they took part in storytelling activities and shared their favourite story characters. Finally, they designed book covers! Year 1 and 2 began the day with a Catwalk to show off their word costumes. Then the Twits arrived in Year 1! The children described Mr Twit and made disgusting beards! In Year 2 they read the book the Lighthouse Keepers lunch they made light houses from paper cups. They used their DT skills to make moving pictures
In Year 3, they read the book, '5 children and it. They then designed their own sand fairy, made their own comic strip based on the book and they thought of dreams. In year 4 the children write a new ending for little red riding hood, created a list of party items then they found out the real price and added it all. Each Year 5 class read a different book and completed activities around each book. The books included the BFG, Harry Potter and the Roald Dahl biography. In Year 6 they were reading a book called The boy at the back of the class by Onjali Q. Rauj. Some of the activities where they wrote diary's like if they were a refuge and they studied on Syria. Finally they made a suitcase for a refuge.
