





























### **Sporting News**

#### OVER-SHARING

This allows other like-minded people to be recommended in searches, if a user likes what they see on sameone's profile, they can initiate conversation through the instant message feature, otherwise they swipe on. The app does use age verification technology when an account is created and groups users by age

#### NTIMATE IMAGES

It's net unheard of for young people to be control into sending suggestive images of themselves over appe of this kind. Given that Wisz connects users with strangers, who may not be honest about their real intentions, a teerager might conceivably be personted to show sensitively suggestive series by someone who they believed they had a unating relationship with.

## NO PARENTAL CONTROLS

The app claims to provide a secure and inclusive environment, but our researcher couldn't find any perental controls or safety ectures in evidence. ## SECRETS AND SUBSCRIPTIONS

## Advice for Parents & Carers

#### TALK IT OUT

If your child has downloaded Wizz, talk to them about why they like it and who've chattad with. Have they shared any personal defails with this person or connected with them on other social media platforms? Refresh your child's memory of the various risks that can arise from engaging with strangers online and get them to consider using a smaller growth more whust sofiely features.

#### **BE SUPPORTIVE**

When connecting with strongers on apps like Witz, seemingly innocent chats can quickly progress to become sexually explicit and lead to nudes being sent. Make sure your child knows to come to you if they're uncomfortable about anything they're been sent or been asked to send. If they're already shared semething that they now regret, reseaure then that you'll support them no matter what.

#### **EMPHASISE CAUTION**



#### IMPORTANT LETTER ABOUT TAKING CHILDREN OUT OF SCHOOL DURING TERM TIME

Dear Families of Monksdown,

Monksdown Primary School is determined to do everything they can to ensure your child has the very best start in life. An essential part of this is that every child is punctual and attends school. As a parent or carer, you have an important part to play. Your child has the right to a good education and **you** have a legal responsibility to ensure that they go to school on time, all of the time.

Pupils should only be absent from school if:

They are too ill to attend

They have a medical appointment that can't be arranged out of school hours

There are exceptional circumstances

Advanced permission has been granted from school

Leave of Absence during term time:

Parents/Carers do not have a right by law to take their child on holiday during school term-time.

Only in exceptional circumstances may school grant leave of absence for a holiday. A written application to the Head Teacher or myself, Chair of Governors, must be made in order for the school to consider this. If a parent/carer takes a child on holiday without prior permission from the school, the Local Authority may issue a Penalty Notice of £120 per child, reduced to £60 if paid within 21 days. Even if a leave of absence is permitted it still counts as an absence and is recorded as Unauthorised. Permission simply means a fixed penalty will not be issued.

If you are experiencing issues with your child's attendance the school's attendance team are there to support. Please contact the school should you require their help.
