English:



This half term we are reading the book Winter's Child. We will be learning about Tom and his love of snow and ice. We will discuss how an unending winter has an affect on the other seasons.

During this unit, we will be recapping previously learned skills and introducing new skills. We will be writing a fantasy story based on the fable.

We will be learning how to:

- Use conjunctions and adverbs
- Build a rich and varied vocabulary.
- Create characters, settings and a plot.
- Use inverted commas to punctuate speech.

Maths:

This half term we will continue focusing on our maths basic skills, including number bonds and addition and subtraction.

Multiplication and Division.

The children will recap learning how to make equal groups, add equal groups and learn about arrays and how it is important to share into equal groups. They will learn how to multiply using the 3, 4- and 8-times tables.

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It will be VITAL that children know, and can recall quickly, their times tables, especially 2, 5, 10 and 3, 4. This half term we will be focusing on the 4 times tables. Remember to use TimesTable Rockstars.

Wider Curriculum in Year 3

Geography - We will be learning about our local area, using maps.

Science - We will be learning about light and shadows, investigating light sources and how they are reflected.

Computing - We will be learning about emails and how to compose them.

RE - We will be learning about the Christian Holy Trinity and why it is important to Christians and their faith.
