Children should bring their reading books to school each day along with their reading records.



English



We will be using the story 'Leon and the Place Between' by Grahame Baker Smith & Angela McAllister to develop writing skills this half term.

In our writing, we will plan our writing by discussing the structure, vocab and grammar of similar writing. We will discuss and record ideas and use these to create our own narratives, create settings, characters and plots. We will assess the effectiveness of our writing by focusing on applying taught skills within our own pieces of writing.

Maths

This half term, children will be focusing on: Multiplication and division

- Multiplying by I and 0
- · Dividing a number by I and itself
- · Multiplying 3 numbers
- Factors and multiples
- Multiplying by 10 and 100
- Dividing by 10 and 100
- · Informal methods for multiplication
- Multiplying 2- and 3-digit numbers by I digit numbers
- Dividing 2- and 3- digit numbers by I digit numbers

Wider Curriculum in Year 4

History - Ancient Greece - Children will locate Greece on a world map and identify why the ancient Greeks were good sailors. They will explore how we know about the Ancient Greeks and discuss what life was like during that era. The children will learn about how the Greeks used to govern their cities and will also learn about some of the wars that took place. They will go on to learn about how Ancient Greece has influenced the rest of the World.

Computing - Scratch coding-Children will learn to use Scratch to code a simple game.

RE - When Jesus left, what was the impact of Pentecost? - Children will find out about the events of Pentecost found in the Bible.

PSHE - Celebrating differences - Children will learn to accept that everyone is different. They will learn how to help someone who is being bullied and learn how to give and receive compliments.

FE - Health related fitness - Children will explore stamina and the meaning of sustained physical exertion along with the importance of keeping physically active. The children will work on core strength, yoga and balancing techniques.

Art - Sketching - Children will practise different shading techniques to create their own 3D drawing of an Ancient Greek bust.
