	The focus of our French lessons will be on practical communication, responding to spoken and written language. The children will be encouraged to speak with increasing confidence and fluency, as well as lengthening the amount of writing produced over the key stage.					
<b>Year 1</b>	The children will begin to learn French and will be learning to greet each other, introduce themselves and count to 10. Listen attentively to spoken language and show understanding. Look at Xmas and how it is celebrated in France.		We will aim to recognise numbers 0-10 and manipulate them with simple maths questions.		Explore the patterns and sounds of language through songs and rhymes. Appreciate stories, songs, poems and rhymes in the language.	
<b>Year 2</b>	We will develop our speaking and listening skills around various topics. We will Practice reading and writing simple familiar French words. We will look at four phonemes: ch, l, a, e. We will learn simple adjectives. Towards the end of the term we will look at Xmas words and how it is celebrated in France.		Speak in sentences using familiar structure. <b>Year 3</b>	Write simple familiar words from memory. Listen attentively to spoken language and show understanding. Speak in sentences using familiar words.		Understand basic grammar points. We will learn songs and rhymes to help internalise new vocabularies. Write short sentences and phrases from memory.	
<b>Year 4</b>	We will reinforce our knowledge of French alphabet and some phonemes in order to develop our reading. Listen to spoken language and show understanding.		Engage in conversation; ask and answer question. Express opinions. Explore the patterns and sounds of language.		Manipulate numbers to 100. of others. <b>Year 5</b>	Understand basic grammar points. Speak in sentences. Listen carefully to spoken language and show understanding		Expressing opinions and to others about school subjects.
