<b>Year 5</b>	<p>Uses a range of materials to produce line, tone and shade</p>	<p>Explores how stimuli can be used as a starting point for 3D work with a particular focus on form, shape, pattern, texture, colour</p> <p>Selects and uses materials to achieve a specific outcome</p>	<p>Create printing blocks by simplifying an initial sketch book idea</p> <p>Use relief of impressed method</p> <p>Create prints with three overlays</p>	<p>Use fabrics to create 3D structures</p> <p>Use different grades of threads and needles</p> <p>Experiment with batik techniques</p>
<b>Year 6</b>	<p>Selects appropriate media and techniques to achieve a specific outcome</p>	<p>Looks at 3D work from a variety of genres and develops own response through experimentation</p> <p>Recreates images in 2D and 3D, looking at one area of experience.</p>	<p>Create prints with three overlays</p> <p>Work into prints with a range of media, e.g. pens, colour pens and paints</p>	<p>Experiment with a range of media to overlap and layer creating interesting colours, textures and effects</p>
