Breakfast Club money must be given in an envelope clearly marked with your child's name, class and amount. Please put dinner money in a separate envelope. The office staff will not accept any money.

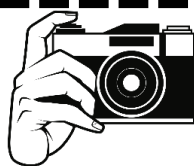
