Dear Parents/Carers,

Our Year 6 children have been enjoying a well deserved break from school this week. They have learnt skills such as team work, perseverance, fitness, agility, risk taking and communication. Many thanks to the Year 6 teaching team for organising the trips and activities.

- ❖ May I remind all KS2 children that they **must** remain on the junior playground until 8:50am when they can wait outside their new classrooms. They must not linger around the new building where they cannot be seen.
- ❖ Some older children are allowed to bring mobile phones to school as they walk home alone. Phones **cannot be used at all** on the school site, either before or after the school day.
- ❖ For safeguarding reasons adults are not allowed in school without reporting to the school office.
- ❖ I have had complaints that some adults are swearing on the playground. Please remember that there are many children milling around before and after school, they should not have to listen to foul language from adults.
- ❖ Please note, children may only leave class early if they have a medical appointment or in the case of an emergency. Children will only be released from class when you arrive to collect them in the main office. Thank you for your co-operation with all of these matters.
- ❖ Hopefully, we will be experiencing some warmer weather during the next couple of months. Please ensure your child is adequately protected from the sun. Apply sun cream before school- we would recommend the once a day type- and provide your child with a cap or sunhat!
- ❖ Please note all children must wear sensible black school shoes- no jelly shoes, trainers or sandals please.
- ❖ As we enter the final term of this academic year, many of our PE lessons will take place outdoors. Please ensure your child has suitable pumps that fit. It is vital that all children wear the correct kit for PE lessons. All kits must be kept in school and taken home each half term for washing. As the weather gets warmer, lessons often take place outdoors have suitable footwear- pumps or trainers. If your child has outgrown their kit and you are unable to purchase a new one at this point in the year, shorts and t-shirts may be worn but no football kits.
