<b>Choose at least one activity from the selection below. Who can complete them all?</b>		
Go for a walk in the park. Collect as many different varieties of leaves as you can. Sort them into size or colour.	Count how many different birds you spot in your garden - can you draw and identify them?	Make a board game to play with your family. Write about the game, what are the rules, who won, was it enjoyable etc. You could even print a picture of you all playing!
Pick two creatures from different habitats - with an adult research things that are the same and things that are different.	Pick any country in Europe. Make a collage of the flag. Coloured paper will be available if needed but old magazines, newspapers, fabric etc. will be best.	Do something kind or helpful every day for a week and record what you did and who it helped. How did this make you feel?
