Bring reading journal in 3 times a week.</i>	Times Tables /Number Facts: <i>Written and orally practise all x tables and related divisions. This will be for a weekly test. Learn number bonds, doubles and halves of numbers to 1000.</i>	Spellings Lists and Dictations: <i>Spellings will be set weekly. There will be a test every Friday. Please learn spellings using 'Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check'. Try to use your spellings as much as possible in speaking and writing.</i>
