<b>Essential Activities</b>		
<p><b>Reading for Pleasure – 20 minutes every night:</b> <i>Talk about the text with an adult. How do you know what the characters are like? Predict what might happen next. Bring reading journal in 3 times a week.</i></p>	<p><b>Times Tables /Number Facts– <i>Written and Orally</i></b> <i>Practise all x tables and related divisions. This will be for a weekly test. Learn number bonds, doubles and halves of numbers to 1000.</i></p>	<p><b>Spellings Lists and Dictations:</b> <i>Spellings will be set weekly. There will be a test every Friday. Please learn spellings using ‘Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check’. Try to use your spellings as much as possible in speaking and writing.</i></p>
<b>Choose at least one activity from the selection below. Who can complete them all?</b>		
<p>Think about what you would like to be when you grow up. Why would you like this sort of job? Why do you think you will be good at it? What qualifications will you need? Write a letter to a future employer, telling them why they should employ you!</p>	<p>Enjoy a family trip out – you can go for a walk, visit the park or a museum.  Simply enjoy some free time away from technology and school work.</p>	<p>We will be studying the Vikings soon. Research what the warrior Vikings may have worn and design a Viking shield or outfit. (Ask your teacher for some A3 paper)</p>
<p>Interview a family member about their job. What do they enjoy about their work, would they recommend it to others, what are the challenges and what qualifications did they need?</p>	<p>Create a piece of ‘Easter Art’  You could create a collage, a sketch or even a model. (Ask for some paper, if you need to!)</p>	<p>Carry out some research on Louis Sachar. Find out as much as you can about the author of Holes and create a fact file on him. Try reading another of his books.</p>
