Banksy is a famous - but anonymous - British graffiti artist. He keeps his identity a secret. He produces pieces of work which pop up in public places, such as on the walls of buildings. A lot of his art is done in a particular style which people can easily recognise.

He began spray painting trains and walls in his home city of Bristol in the early 1990s. Bristol is well known for its colourful street art and graffiti. But in the 2000s, he expanded his work beyond Bristol and was soon leaving his artistic mark all over the world, including a giant rat in Liverpool.
